

# WEATHER FUN!

This is a game for 2-4 players (or teams). Before playing the game revise or pre-teach the vocabulary used in the activity. To do this, you can use question cards as flashcards.

Shuffle question cards and put in a pile face up (answer side down).

Take a turn by flipping a coin:  
heads = move one space; tails = move two spaces.

When you land on a square with the flower, you take a card from the top of the pile, read the question, then answer. Each correct answer gains points.

The questions have three different levels of difficulty and are coded with stars.

easy	★	1 point
medium	★★	2 points
hard	★★★	3 points

Give yourself one point for each easy question you get right, two points for each medium question you get right, and three points for each hard question you get right.

If you are right, don't move.  
If you are wrong, move back one space.

The player with the highest score is the winner.

## Preparation

Print out a game board and question cards. If you want, you can stick the printout onto the heavy paper.  
Cut out the individual cards, fold them and glue.  
You can laminate your game board and cards for future use.

## MATERIALS



a game board



question cards



a coin



a place marker for each player

You can use buttons or pawns as markers.

If you would like to make your own markers, you can use our templates.
