







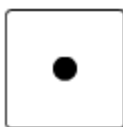


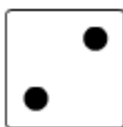

Say it in a positive sentence.
For example, 1-1: cook
I cook well.



Say it in a negative sentence.
For example, 1-2: cook
We don't cook well.



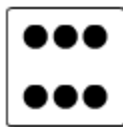
Say it in a question.
For example, 1-3: cook
Do you cook well?



Say it in a positive sentence (3rd person singular).
For example, 1-4: cook
He cooks well.



Say it in a negative sentence (3rd person singular).
For example, 1-5: cook
He doesn't cook well.



Say it in a question (3rd person singular).
For example, 1-6: cook
Does he cook well?
