

PRESENT SIMPLE. QUESTION FORM

To make the question forms, we use **do** or **does** before the subject and the base form of the verb.



Do / Does	SUBJECT	VERB	OBJECT
-----------	---------	------	--------

Do	I	like	cats?
----	---	------	-------

Do	you	like	bats?
----	-----	------	-------

Does	he	like	dogs?
------	----	------	-------

Does	she	like	frogs?
------	-----	------	--------

Does	it	like	snails?
------	----	------	---------

Do	we	like	whales?
----	----	------	---------

Do	you	like	bears?
----	-----	------	--------

Do	they	like	hares?
----	------	------	--------

We use question forms to ask something.

do I sing
do you sing
does he sing
does she sing
does it sing

do we sing
do you sing
do they sing

?



do I teach
do you teach
does he teach
does she teach
does it teach

do we teach
do you teach
do they teach

?



do I cry
do you cry
does he cry
does she cry
does it cry

do we cry
do you cry
do they cry

?



Short answers

If the question starts with **Do** or **Does**, it is called a Yes/No question, because it requires a short answer.

Do...?

I you
we they

Yes, I do.
Yes, you do.
Yes, we do.
Yes, they do.

No, I don't.
No, you don't.
No, we don't.
No, they don't.

Does...?

he it
she

Yes, he does.
Yes, she does.
Yes, it does.

No, he doesn't.
No, she doesn't.
No, it doesn't.

Do you play tennis?

Yes, I do.
